RÁQUIRA



Characterized by its work in clay, woven bags, baskets, clothing, and hammocks. They are also potters and traditional "Olleros". This little town, has been working the clay since before the arrival of the Spaniards to the American territory and since then, their crafts has been host to a point that are currently exported to various parts of the United States and Europe. Undoubtedly, visit this place is transported into the past century, in which hides much of the history of our country, as is the case of the convent of La Candelaria, located in the desert of the same name. It is located 80 kilometers from Tunja, and very close to the desert of La Candelaria.

EL SALTO DEL TEQUENDAMA

This natural waterfall as myths, was created after a flood caused by chibchacum. The Muisca, conducted fasts and sacrifices to the god Bochica asking them to help and he appeared with their cheap gold and he opened the rock that was interrupting the passing of the river and it well established.

El Salto del Tequendama, is formed with the waters of the Rio Bogotá, on the edge of the Sabana de Bogota, in the municipality of Soacha 30 km from Bogota. The branch is located at an altitude above the sea level of 2467 m and has a vertical drop of 157 m. The majesty of the landscape has made EL SALTO into a tourist attraction.
